After working in Tier4 mental health hospitals as a therapeutic crisis intervention practitioner for over seven years Steve qualified as a Social Worker in 2002 at John Moores University, Liverpool and worked in the Child Protection and Court Team on Merseyside; becoming a Senior CP Practitioner before leaving to join Barnardo's in 2005.

Steve spent 12 years working and managing a specialist team with Barnardo's, risk assessing and offering therapeutic intervention with children, young people and adults who displayed problematic and harmful sexualised and violent behaviours. The service offered a forensic, clinical, safeguarding and traumainformed approach to assessment, safety planning and therapeutic intervention.

Steve has worked extensively in the forensic, clinical and safeguarding field of Child Sexual Abuse (CSA). Steve's work includes forensic assessment, CSA assessment, protective guardian assessment and specialist intervention instructed by court, or commissioned by local authorities, and private organisations covering the UK, Ireland, Jersey, Isle of Man and the USA.

Steve has been an independent Social Work Consultant for the past 15 years, becoming the Director of his own limited company Steve Bore Specialist Services Ltd in March 2017, and continues to provide professional Assessment, Training, Consultancy and Intervention nationally and internationally.
